### **Where does the money come from?**

The government provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 / 2016 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

This funding has continued to come to schools and details of how much we receive at St George's and how we use it are shown on our [PE Action plan](#). The impact this has made on children's PE and Sport experiences are in the report below.

This funding is ring-fenced which means it can only be spent on provision of PE and Sport in schools.

The school has really benefitted, and having two PE specialist in school to help promote PE and Sport has made a big difference to the quality of the PE taught, the sports events and activities children now take part in, and the broad range of sports we have been able to offer on our Healthy Heart and Mind days.
