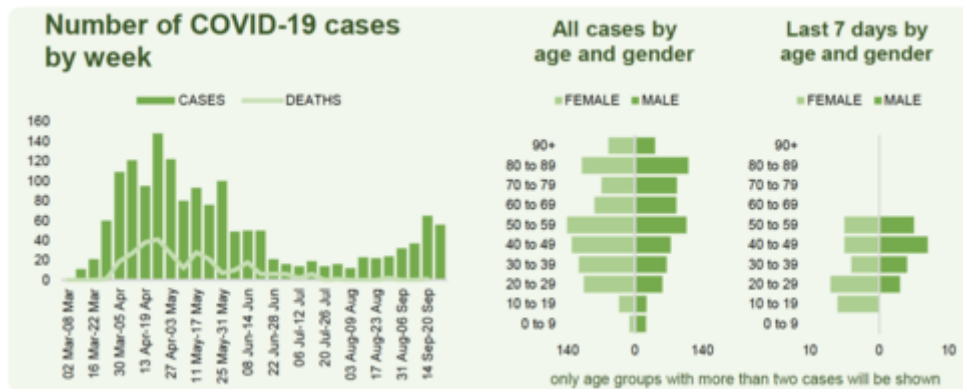
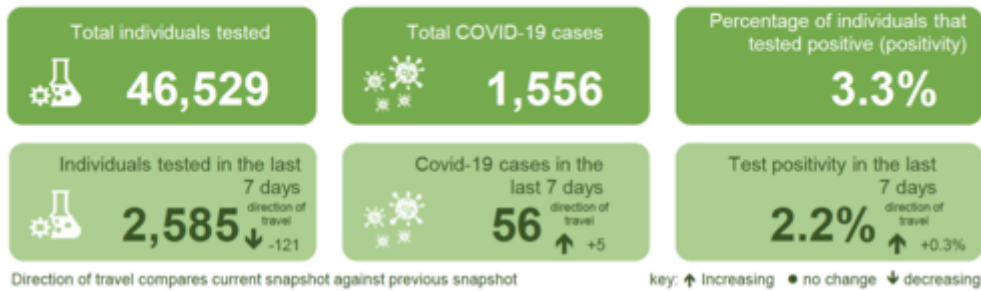


# COVID-19 Snapshot

## Weekly figures

The number of people testing positive for Coronavirus in the last week (week ending 27 September) has increased by five cases compared to the same point last week to 56 cases.

Although this appears to be a small increase compared to the previous week, this a significant increase from the 25 cases reported three weeks ago and sadly there has been one death in Central Bedfordshire which hasn't been the case for some time.

In line with the rest of the country infections are on the rise and we will be strongly urging the public to continue their efforts to keep the virus under control and avoid a lockdown.

The headline statistics from our Public Health partner councils are provided below:

- Luton: 122 cases (up 22 from the previous week)
- Bedford: 72 cases (up 23 from the previous week) and one death
- Milton Keynes: 56 cases (up 12 from the previous week)

The number of cases is shown by Middle Super Output Areas (MSOAs) which have on average a population of 7,800 in each area.
