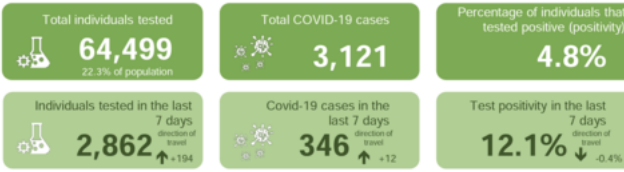

COVID-19 Snapshot

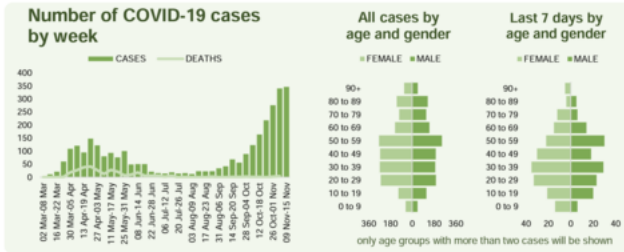
As of 18th November 2020 (data reported up to 15th November 2020)

Weekly figures

This week we've seen an increase in 12 cases, whilst this might seem a small increase from last week we must not be complacent as there were still 346 new COVID-19 cases in the last week and more importantly four deaths.

Everyone must play their part in controlling the spread of the virus. Remember to:

- socially distance from anyone you don't live with

- Luton: 600 cases (up 63 from the previous week)
