

Weekly figures

This week, in Central Bedfordshire we've seen 225 new COVID-19 cases. This is 31 cases less than last week and 121 less than two weeks ago. However, like last week, we are still reporting sadly another six deaths.

Also, it is important to consider the situation in other areas close to us, all three of the areas list below have seen a drop in new cases which is good news:

- Luton 513 cases and 5 deaths
- Milton Keynes 376 cases and 8 deaths
- Bedford 171 cases and 7 deaths
