
Food Glorious Food

Literacy

We will be reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl as a class, and using the text to write descriptions of settings and characters. The children will write their own fantasy story through writing a new chapter for the book.

Our grammar will focus on:

- Conjunctions of time and place.
- Plural and possessive 's'.
- Speech punctuation.



Maths

We will develop knowledge and understanding of number and place value, written addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, and shape, measures, position and direction and statistics.

Science

In Chemistry we will be focusing on Changing States of Matter. The children will learn about solids, liquids and gases and will explore how materials can be changed through melting, heating and freezing.

Geography

Children will learn to name and locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on North and South America, concentrating on environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries and major cities. They will study geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the UK and a region within South America.



RE

Children will be looking at how, where and why people worship. As part of their studies, using virtual tours, the children will have the opportunity to go inside a C of E Church, a Gurdwara, a Synagogue and a Mosque to gain experience of what these buildings are like and how they are used in worship.

PE

Games; Hockey

The children will explore and develop large ball skills, and use these in a variety of team games.

Dance:

The children will take part in fitness dance routines and will develop their own routines to music.



Computing

Using Purple Mash the children will learn to code.



PSHE

Children will think about their dreams and goals for the future..

The children will explore this through discussion of different everyday situations.

Art and Design

The children will study the work of the illustrator Quentin Blake, looking at the techniques he uses carefully. They will produce their own illustrations in the style of Quentin Blake using water colours and ink.

Design Technology

Children will be involved in two Food Technology projects. They will make a cous-cous salad. Linking in with our science and literacy they will plan, design and create their own chocolate sweets.

Music

This half-term we hope to commence Sing Up. The children will begin to learn a variety of songs with an animateur from Bedfordshire Inspiring Music. This will continue and culminate in a concert which you will be able to attend later in the year.



French
