LITERACY

We will be focusing on traditional tales; discussing characters and settings. We shall rewrite traditional tales, plan alternative endings and write narratives. We will be focusing on using a range of sentence starters and connectives using subordination and co-ordination. We will continue our focus on grammar including types of sentences, use of tenses, commas in lists and adverbs.

Design Technology

We will be designing, making and evaluating moving pictures. Experimenting with different mechanisms to make the pictures move.

Music

We will be listening to castle music, Chants and canticles by choirs. We will be thinking about what instruments are used and how it makes us feel. We will then be playing some of the pieces

Physical Education

During inside PE we will be learning a palace dance. During outside PE we will be starting a unit called hit, catch and run.

These will be looking at different catching and throwing skills building to small team games.

Art

We will be studying representations of dragons in art such as Uccello's St. George and the Dragon painting and using these as inspiration for our own art work.

Mathematics

Building on last term's work we continue to practise quick recall of the number facts. We will focus on place value and being able to count on and back from different starting points; We shall record addition and subtraction of single, two and even three digit numbers. We continue to practise the multiplication tables. Children will continue to work on problem solving and explaining their thinking.

Religious Education

We are thinking about what we can learn from different sacred books and stories. We will look for hidden meanings within these stories and what symbols are important to different faiths.

History

We will be learning about castles, such as the names and functions of parts of a castle, who lived in a castle and what life was like in a castle.

Geography

We shall try to answer questions such as 'Why were castles located where they were?' We shall look at maps and learn about different symbols and features on a map.

Computing

In computing we will be learning about how to present our ideas electronically using quizzes, publisher and presenting data.

PSHE

This term we will be thinking about our dreams and goals. How we all play a part in a team and think about our feelings and those of others.
