Parent Forum Meetings

As I mentioned last week, as strategic leaders, we are moving our focus to evaluating the quality of education. Ofsted have announced that visits to schools will resume in September 2021. Free School Meals

The Covid pandemic has impacted families in so many ways and for many this will be financially. If your working circumstances have changed, or you have started receiving an income-related benefit, such as Income Support or Child Tax Credit, your child may now be eligible for free school meals. It is easy to check whether your child is eligible, you just call Central Beds Council on 0300 300 8306 and have your NI number ready. If your child is eligible there are other resources the school could receive for your child, and this is explained in the attached letter.
