The children and staff have enjoyed another fabulous week of learning. As you know, our approach has been about recovering from the disruption that all children have experienced in their education. Teachers report that St. George's children have coped incredibly well, and are so pleased to see them enjoying their learning once again.

The summer term curriculum has been adapted to prioritise key concepts for each year group. Teachers are closely tracking the objectives that they cover and assessing how secure

the children are in applying them. Any current year group objectives that are less secure, will be built into and inform curriculum planning for September 2021.

Teachers continue to use assessment tools and strategies, to assess children's next steps, as part of their typical teaching practice. As we did in the Autumn term, we will be informing parents and carers, of any particular individual targets for your child, if we believe that they would benefit from a little more practice at home. Details of this will be sent home over the next few weeks.

We also know that parents and carers are keen to support their children in their learning and so we will be holding zoom parent workshops on how to help your child at home.
