Literacy

We will be starting the term learning about list poems. We will then do a focus week on remembrance creating an explanation text. Moving onto traditional tales and instruction writing finishing the term doing a focus week on the nativity.

Mathematics

We will be starting by continuing our work on number – addition and subtraction methods. We will then move onto measurement focusing mainly on money and we will finish off the term consolidating all our learning so far.

PHSE

This term we will be thinking celebrating differences. How we have things in common and how we are different.

Physical Education

We will complete units of study on dance and outside we will be starting a unit called hit, catch and run. These will be looking at different catching and throwing skills building to small team games.

Music

This is a six-week Unit of Work that builds on previous learning. All the learning is focused around one song: Ho Ho Ho - a Christmas song. We will Listen & Appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and playing.
