Identify how language, structure, and presentation contribute to meaning.


Orally compose and write sentences using an increasing range of vocabulary and sentence structures.

Propose changes to grammar and vocabulary to improve consistency, including the accurate use of pronouns in sentences.

Assess the effectiveness of their own and others' writing, noticing some ways to improve the grammar, vocabulary or conventions of the genre. Plan their writing.

Discuss writing similar to that which they are planning to write in order to understand and learn from its structure, vocabulary and grammar.

Use plans to write a newspaper report, ensuring that the first paragraph summarises the whole story as concisely as possible
