ENGLISH

Skills focus:

Read their writing aloud, clearly enough to be heard by other children and the teacher.
Read words with contractions.
Link what they read or hear to their own experiences and understanding of a topic or events.

Use subject-specific vocabulary to explain and describe.
Say out loud what they are going to write about, making simple pictorial or written records where appropriate.
Participate in group talk, role play and performances.

Write a sentence or sequence of sentences for a given purpose.

Listen to, enjoy and talk about poems, stories and non-fiction texts.

Sit and hold a pencil correctly and begin to form lower-case letters, capital letters, handwriting families and digits correctly.

Begin to use punctuation (capital letter, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark).

Sequence sentences to form short texts using some sequencing words or formulaic phrases, including those to indicate the start or end of a text.

Leave spaces between words and join words and clauses using 'and'.


Reread their writing to check that it makes sense.
