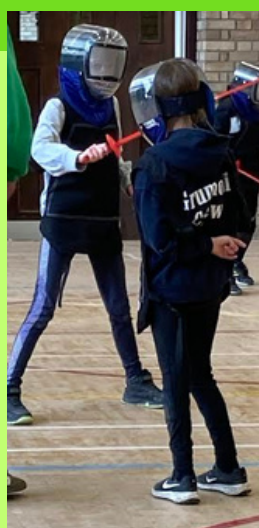




## KINGSWOOD ACTIVITY CENTRE

Everyone agreed that it was an awesome trip!

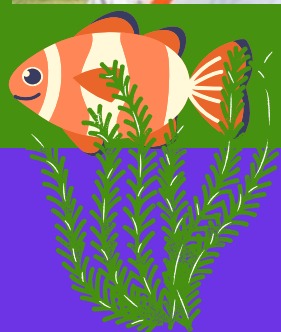
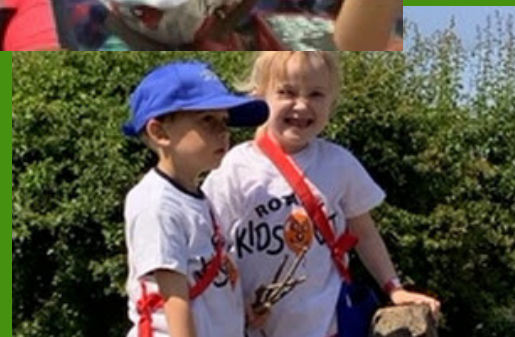
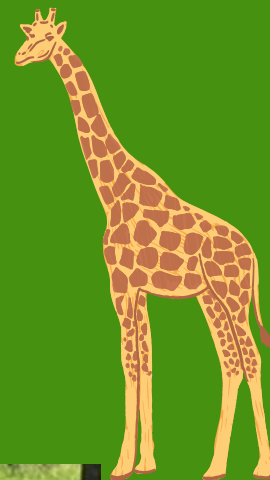




# WE WENT TO THE ZOO!

I gathered ideas and vocabulary in my Literacy lessons, then wrote a rhyming couplet poem about Boudica.

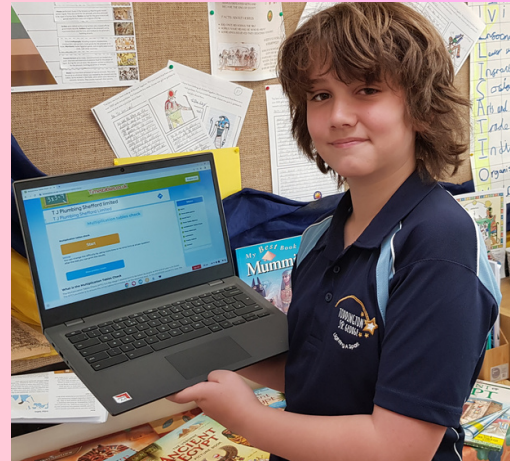
I ordered and paid for my Happy Meal.
